

## COMPETITIVE TEAM QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES 2007-2008

TEAM	SELECTION CRITERIA
<b>Elite Team</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Senior singles, pairs and dance teams with a top half finish in final at Canadians</li> <li>• Junior singles, pairs, and dance entries finishing in the top half of their event at Canadians</li> <li>• Any skater byed through to Canadians by Skate Canada</li> <li>• Any Novice skater who places in the top 3 at Junior Nationals.</li> <li>• Qualification is for one year</li> </ul>
<b>Select Team</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All qualification is at the AB/NWT/Nunavut Sectional Championships</li> <li>• Qualification is for one year</li> <li>• Pre-Novice to Senior level skaters who qualify for the Western Challenge, Junior Nationals and Canadians through Sectionals.</li> <li>• If there are 4 or fewer skaters at the Sectional Event, those skaters who qualify for Canadians or Junior Nationals, or who achieve a top half placement in their respective Challenge event (whichever is greater) will qualify for the Select Team.</li> </ul>
<b>Junior Development Team</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Qualification at AB/NWT/Nunavut Sectional Championships each year</li> <li>• Qualification is for one year</li> <li>• Pre-Novice 5-8</li> <li>• Juvenile 1-6</li> <li>• Pre-Juvenile 1-5</li> <li>• The Athlete Development Committee reserves the right to name up to 5 skaters or teams to the Development Team based on competitive results at a sectional or StarSkate level and/or development potential.</li> <li>• Age requirement: Singles - Men 14 years or younger and Ladies 13 years or under on or before July 1<sup>st</sup> preceding the qualifying Sectional event. Pairs and Dance – 16 years for Men, 14 for Ladies.</li> </ul>
