## JUVENILE SINGLES CLINIC – August 7, 2010

### General

As well as attendance at a clinic; trial evaluating and trial judging of tests and competitions will be required for an appointment. As there is a new rule regarding judges and evaluators having to upgrade by attending an educational judging activity every 3 years, candidates are welcome to attend as “observers”.

### Juvenile Singles Judge

**Levels covered:** Juvenile Singles. This clinic is offered in conjunction with the Wild Rose Competition. Clinic participants will have the opportunity to trial live events and obtain Referee reports that can be used for feedback and promotion purposes.

NOTE: Please note that it is not a mandatory requirement to hold Primary Judges status to take this clinic.

Participants who successfully complete the required classroom time, exam and trial requirements are eligible for a Juvenile Singles judge promotion. As a Juvenile Judge you will be able to judge the Juvenile level and below single events at competitions. You can then continue working towards completing the necessary requirements for other disciplines or Novice Singles promotion.

### Registration Information

A \$50 (candidate)/\$10 (observer) registration fee must be submitted with this registration form to Section Office. Upon attendance at the clinic, Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Section candidates will be entitled to a full \$50/\$10 refund, which will be mailed to candidates after the clinic is completed. Cancellations will be accepted up until 1 week prior to the clinic, with full refund. Late cancellations and No Shows may apply for a 50% refund (\$25/\$5) of the Registration Fee.

Observer registrations will be accepted; based on space availability and at the discretion of the Section Evaluator/Judges Sub-Committee – manuals will not be provided for observers. Please arrive 15-20 minutes prior to the start time of the clinic for Check-in/Sign-in

- Skate Canada Manuals will be provided at no charge; and will be distributed at the clinic.
